- 1. When will UNNATURAL CAUSES is going to air on my local PBS station? Most stations will broadcast four consecutive Thursdays at 10PM (9PM Central): March 27, April 3, 10, and 17, 2008.

- 2. How can I order the series on DVD and how much does it cost? UNNATURAL CAUSES is available through <a href="www.newsreel.org">www.newsreel.org</a> or tool free at 877-811-7495. Note that orders placed in March will ship the first week of April.

Prices for the four hour series (including public performance rights) are as follows:

- \$295 for colleges, universities, corporations and government agencies. If five or more titles are purchased at the same time, each copy will be discounted to \$199.
- \$79.95 for high schools, public libraries, and nonprofit community-based organizations (such as church groups and civic organizations)
- \$49 per DVD for orders of 50 or more. Please call 877-811-7495 to place bulk orders.
- **3.** Can I web cast the series or show it on our public access station? NO. PBS has exclusive rights to show the series. You may use the DVDs to host a screening.

- **4. Is the series available in other languages?** YES. The DVDs will have Spanish audio and captions, but those will NOT be available until May 2008.
